

Sensorimotor Prewriting Groups

***Before you can write it, you have to feel it in your own body!
What is up, down, middle, right and left?
How do we go around?
Children will learn these fundamental concepts through sensorimotor fun.***

The skills involved in learning to write are called **pre-writing skills**. These include the sensorimotor skills that contribute to a child holding and using a pencil, and the ability to draw, copy, and colour.

This group is designed to help your child master the skills necessary for successful formation of letters and numbers.

It focuses on development of sensorimotor components required for letter formations, and gives children a solid motor foundation for a task that is taught predominantly in a visual way at school. It helps develop correct formations, spatial awareness and directionality and helps prevent reversals.

- This group is an excellent preparation for children in their preschool years.
- It is designed to complement our existing groups including *Fantastic Finger Fun*, *Ready, Set, School* and our *Holiday Handwriting Intensives*.
- It involves tactile experiences such as making letters with your whole body, with manipulatives such as pipe cleaners, play dough, foam, and more.
- It focuses on hand strengthening, correct holding of the crayon/marker/pencil and basic drawing of shapes will be used to reinforce emerging graphomotor skills. We combine this with kinesthetic, visual and auditory cues to ensure whole body and multi-modal learning.
- It makes learning lots of fun!
